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Competition Rules

Sanctioned as an Age Group Swimming Invitational by Swim Ontario.

All current [Swimming Canada rules](#) will be followed.

All swimmers are permitted to race with the swimwear of their choosing at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Ontario provided the fabric of the swimwear is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to create a technical advantage in terms of speed, buoyancy, or endurance.

Eligibility

All athletes must be registered as **Competitive** swimmers with Swimming Canada and possess a valid Swimming Canada registration number. Entries submitted without a valid registration number and active status in the Swimming Canada Registration and Event Management System (REMS) at the time of the competition will be denied entry. It is the responsibility of the swimmer's club to provide proof of active registration status in REMS.

ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION:	<p>This is a closed invitational that includes the following Clubs: AAD, BRANT, BROCK, BTSC, CATS, CCSC, HSC, NYBT, OSAC, OTTER, PTBO, ROC, SLSC.</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Preference will be given to the host club first.</p>
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COACH & SUPPORT STAFF REGISTRATION:	<p>Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches submitted with entries at this competition with the Swim Ontario Compliance lists. If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the Swimming Canada policy and not permit that coach to attend the meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.</p> <p>Swimmers must have a coach or designated coach (coach representative) in attendance during the meet including warm-up sessions.</p> <p>Clubs needing Support Staff for Para or d/Deaf/Hard of Hearing swimmers must register them in the Swimming Canada Registration and Event Management System (REMS) to access the deck at competitions. Support Staff must have active REMS registration and be included in the club's event entry. Those not listed in the entry submission will be denied deck access.</p>
FOREIGN TEAMS / COMPETITORS:	<p>The following applies to Teams and their competitors not affiliated with Swimming Canada. Entry Process

ENTRY SUBMISSIONS:	<p>Entries must be submitted through the Swimming Canada Registration and Events System (REMS) and must include all attending coaches and support staff. Meet management will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • not accept entries via email; • notify clubs within 48 hours of the online entry deadline regarding any rejected entries or required changes to entries; • notify clubs of any meet format changes or designated warm-up times at least 5 days (for TIER II sanctions) and 10 days (for TIER III & IV sanctions) prior to the start of the competition <p>Failure to inform meet management of a no-show / scratch prior to the deadline for changes to entries will result in loss of entry fees.</p> <p>Meet Management reserves the right to further limit individual swims per session and to limit heats if necessary to keep session times to within 4.5 hours.</p>

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RELAY ENTRIES:	<p>Teams may move up no more than two (2) swimmers from a younger age category to fill a relay. A mixed relay must have 2 girls and 2 boys. No other combination is allowed. The first leg of a mixed relay is not an official time. Requests for official splits are not allowed for mixed relays.</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Relay swimmers must be entered in a non-relay event in order to compete.</p>

Meet Format & Administration

MIXED-GENDER:	<p>An exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events due to limited time, developmental opportunities or facility requirements and/or due to a missed swim, where on an exception basis, a referee agrees to have the swimmer swim with a heat of an opposite gender event.</p> <p>In spite of these exemptions, any swimmer who achieves a record time at a competition that recognizes records at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start of the session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee ensures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat.</p> <p>In the event that mixed gender swims are permitted, the results must still be posted separately by gender of swimmers.</p>
SEEDING:	<p>After all times are converted as pursuant to the conversion process:</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Seeding for Timed Final events will be in order of entry times, slowest to fastest. Swimmers entered with NT (no time) will be seeded last.</p>
DECK ENTRIES:	<p>All accepted Deck Entries are Exhibition Only and are not eligible for scoring or awards. No new heats will be created for deck entries (only empty lanes, if available). AWARDS:	<p>The following will be awarded:</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Ribbons for 1st - 6th place for individual events. Age groups are as follows: 10 and under, 11 & 12, 13 & 14, and 15 and over for both males and females. No awards will be provided for relay events.</p>
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:	<p>Last chance OSC qualifying Time Trial events will be available on a first come, first served basis to any athlete already participating in the Meet. There are 4 available heats; Heats 1 & 2 will take place at the beginning of Session 2. Heats 3 & 4 will take place at the beginning of Session 3. Entries are to be sent directly to Meet Management by midnight on June 19th, 2025.</p> <p>Morning warm up sessions will be divided to accommodate swimmer numbers. Clubs will be contacted prior to the event to confirm assignments. There will be a short split warm-up session prior to the afternoon session.</p> <p>Please note: USE OF BARBEQUES IS PROHIBITED. Food and beverages will be available on site at a reasonable cost. Swimmers are prohibited from eating on the pool deck.</p> <p>All swimmers, coaches, volunteers, spectators attending this unique indoor/outdoor event have a duty to demonstrate maturity and to conduct themselves in a positive and respectable manner. Please be aware that the entire venue on and off the pool deck is subject to a no smoking/vaping policy and consumption of alcoholic beverages or use of recreational drugs is not permitted. Consequences for inappropriate conduct may include the request to leave the premises, removal of an athlete from the competition or involvement with municipal law enforcement agencies.</p> <p>THE SKATE PARK ADJACENT TO THE POOL IS ONLY TO BE USED AS INTENDED. LOUNGING OR LOITERING IN THE SKATE PARK IS NOT PERMITTED.</p> <p>What to bring: Our pool is enclosed and climate controlled, but much will be happening outside on the surrounding grounds. Be prepared for the elements!! Bring hats, sunscreen,</p>

	<p>blankets, tents, etc. We recommend each team bring an open-sided canopy/tent for their team (protection from the sun and/or rain).</p> <p>Special events: There will be special events during the lunch hour on both Saturday and Sunday. Team participation and friendly competition is encouraged.</p> <p>Come prepared for the famous cardboard boat race, lip sync contest and many other fun events and contests as well.</p> <p>Please Note: The enclosed concrete area outside the garage doors of the pool is reserved for athletes only.</p> <p>ELIMINATOR EVENT: Prize Event \$100.00 each for top Male and Female.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Following the 50 Free event, we will identify the 6 fastest 50 Free swimmers for each gender, ages 13 and over. 2. Coaches will be requested to indicate if their swimmer will be participating at least 2 hours prior to the start of event. This will allow us to identify alternate swimmers, if required. 3. There will be 5 heats, with the slowest swimmer in each heat being eliminated. 4. We will alternate males and females, to allow for the heat to reset, after elimination. 5. The heats will continue until we identify the fastest swimmer for each gender. <p>ELIMINATOR EVENT WILL TAKE PLACE SUNDAY AFTER THE END OF SESSION 3, AS TIME PERMITS.</p>
