

CVAC Family Participation Policy

Introduction

Purpose

The goal of this policy is to distribute the volunteer responsibilities evenly among all members, ensuring that everyone contributes to the club's success.

Volunteer Requirements

- 1. Ripple Families: Each family is required to volunteer at least three (3) times per year.
- 2. Swell and Tidal Families: Each family is required to volunteer at least four (4) times per year.
- 3. **Families with Multiple Swimmers**: These families are required to volunteer at least **four (4) times per year**.

Volunteer Opportunities

Families can fulfill their volunteer requirements through various activities, including but not limited to:

- · Officiating at swim meets
- Organizing fundraisers
- · Planning and executing club events
- Signing up to help at swim meets

Volunteer Substitutes

Families may recruit extended family members or friends to volunteer on their behalf. However, please note that swimmers volunteering at meets will not count towards the family's volunteer requirements.

Tracking and Reporting

The club will keep track of each family's participation level, which will be reviewed twice a season. It is the responsibility of each family to ensure their volunteer hours are reported accurately.

Review and Amendment
