Upcoming Hosted Events:


Thursday, April 10 - Saturday, April 12th, 2025 - CANADIAN SWIMMING OPEN

This event will feature the fastest swimmers from across the country, including many of our Olympic heroes from Paris 2024! It promises to be an exciting and pivotal occasion, and we are in need of our dedicated volunteers to help ensure everything runs smoothly. Your involvement is encouraged and will make a significant difference in making this event a success.

- Edmonton Keyano has the privilege of hosting the **next 4 Canadian Opens** and, as a part of that agreement Keyano will not be hosting our typical annual provincial meet. Performance families, though you may not have a swimmer participating in the Canadian Open please volunteer for this meet as a replacement for volunteering at Provincials.
- **Important:** hosting senior events such as this is possible only through help from ALL of our members whether your swimmer is attending or not. We must support our most senior level swimmers.

All volunteers/officials must have a separate form. This includes swimmers or other family members that would like to volunteer. Please complete this form before MARCH 5th. It saves many hours of work for volunteers if everyone can complete this in advance. Priority for shifts and roles will be determined by this form and experience/seniority.

Participation Points Update:

You can check your balance on eksc.com when signed into the website. Go to your account and under '*JOB CREDIT*' you can see your balance.

I am also posting a spreadsheet of the accounts as they were on February 6th. You can <u>click HERE</u> for that information. It is organized by groups so if you have more than one swimmer, your total will only show for one group.

It takes the entire club to host 5 large events a season. There is no buy-out option for participation points. We need your help on deck or we cannot host events for all of our swimmer(s), from Silver to Senior National! We encourage you to get involved. Whether that be officiating, electronics, or assisting in various organisational roles, there really is something for everyone. Try a few different roles and see which you prefer. Or bring a family member or sibling to help pass the time and work off participation points quickly.

SWIMMING CANADA - REMS UPDATE

We encourage you to sign into the <u>sportlomo website</u> and confirm that all your credentials are up to date. All members must be active and up to date before the 2025 Canadian Swimming Open.

INTRODUCTION TO SWIMMING OFFICIATING - E-MODULE

This is the entry level clinic to become a timer and begin working your participation points that fulfil your club requirement. Anyone that was unable to attend the in-person training session earlier this season is invited to sign up for the E-MODULE by emailing <u>officials@eksc.com</u>.

SAFETY MARSHAL - E-MODULE

Anyone that has completed the Introduction clinic and the Safety Marshal clinic and has worked in a timer position this season, can now register for the Inspector of Turns clinic.
