FACILITY ENTRY

Entry through Door 4

Door 4 is up the main entry staircase to the Kinsmen, but go to the right just before reaching the main entrance. There will be signage to help you find your way. **Use the main staircase and stay right.**

Competitors, Volunteers and Coaches are asked to enter the facility through Door 4 throughout the meet. Parents will also be allowed through this entry-way.

Access to the pool deck will be from the North-West spectators area, near the Kinette Room. A security volunteer will allow only coaches, swimmers and volunteers onto the pool deck area.

FACILITY PARKING

Overflow Parking damaged; Carpool & Alternate Parking

There is a portion of the parking lot reserved for EKI participants, however it will likely not be enough parking for every swimmer, parent, coach, official & spectator. Please carpool or drop off whenever possible.

Parking Guard & Parking Pass

A portion of the Kinsmen parking lot will be reserved for EKI participants. To access the parking lot you will need to show a parking pass on your phone (or paper if you print it out).

MEET PACKAGE REMINDERS

Scratch Deadlines

Please pay attention to deadlines:

- Up until Wednesday at 5pm, all scratches accepted by email to entries@eksc.com
- Prelims scratches due immediately following previous finals sessions (5 minutes)
- Finals scratches due **30 minutes before** the end of Prelims; this means before the distance events have concluded.

As a courtesy to keep the meet running as quickly as possible, please submit all scratches and notify no-shows prior to an event racing.

Relay Cards

During prelims each day, coaches must pick up their relay cards from the clerk of course. Coaches shall write the correct order of swimmers on these cards and swimmers shall deliver the card to their lane timer immediately before their race. In so doing, coaches may make changes to their relay team order as required until they submit their card.
