#### **FACILITY ENTRY**

## Entry through Door 4; Up Main Entrance Stairs – door to the right

Door 4 is the most convenient entrance as it avoids going through the cafeteria. It is up the main entry staircase to the Kinsmen but go to the right just before reaching the main entrance. There will be signage to help you find your way. *Use the main staircase and stay right.* 

Access to the pool deck will be from the North-West spectators area, near the Kinette Room. A security volunteer will allow only coaches, swimmers and volunteers onto the pool deck area.

#### **FACILITY PARKING**

## **Overflow Parking damaged; Carpool & Alternate Parking**

There is a portion of the parking lot reserved for EKI participants, however it will likely not be enough parking for every swimmer, parent, coach, official & spectator. Please carpool or drop off whenever possible.

## **Parking Guard & Parking Pass**

A portion of the Kinsmen parking lot will be reserved for EKI participants. To access the parking lot you will need to show a parking pass on your phone (or paper if you print it out).

<u>Parking Passes are on the EKI webpage</u>. You can print these or present this on your mobile phone when you get to the Kinsmen. You will not need a pass on your dashboard; only for entry to the lot.

## Swimmers report to blocks

We will be running Finals efficiently in order to complete all of the Finals in a reasonable time. Our announcers will name swimmers after the start of the race; swimmers should be ready to race without delay in the event order laid out in the meet package.

## Awards from the podium

Medals, bell heats and Swim of the Day Awards will be presented at the podium / awards table.



#### **MEET FORMAT**

## **Start End for Racing Events**

50m events will run from the East / Scoreboard end of the pool. All other events will start from the West / Deep Tank end of the pool.

#### **Positive Check-in Events**

Please ensure you meet all positive check in deadlines as per the meet package. Check-in forms will be available at the Admin Desk at least 15min before warm-ups start, daily. 800m and 1500m races will include the option to swim in the morning session.

## Para Swimmers declaring to swim Olympic stream finals

Para Swimmers have the opportunity to declare themselves as Olympic stream athletes if they so wish. This may be done on an event-by-event basis, however, this decision must be declared prior to the session in which they swim each event. The Admin Desk will accept all declarations for Para Swimmers wishing to compete at Olympic stream athletes. Should a Para swimmer declare themselves as eligible for the Olympic stream final, they will be ineligible for the Para stream final for the same event.


