

## **FAST Policies at a Glance**

## Background:

In 2015 FAST was granted Level I certification with the Club Excellence organization. Part of the requirements for this certification was to ensure the club operates with transparency and consistency through its policies and guidelines. Alumni Swimmers	<ul> <li>If there is room and at the discretion of the head coach, FAST alumni varsity swimmers may be able to attend FAST practices once their "off season"</li> </ul>
Apparel & Equipment Policy	<ul> <li>FAST takes great pride in its brand and believes there is a connection between team clothing and team spirit/unity</li> <li>there are clothing/swim gear items that are required to have for each group</li> <li>outside use of FAST logo is prohibited to ensure consistency of our brand/offerings to all members</li> <li>morning practices – swim suit is swimmers choice</li> <li>afternoon practices – must wear FAST Team Suit (Speedo Endurance)</li> <li>swim meets – must wear FAST Team Suit (Speedo Endurance)</li> <li>no other performance suit may be worn at swim meets without prior coach approval</li> </ul>
Chaperone Policy	all chaperones must have a valid police check including vulnerable sector check
Code of Conduct for Swimmers	<ul> <li>is reviewed by all swimmers with their coach at the beginning of each swim season</li> </ul>
Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians	<ul> <li>is required and included as part of FAST Registration</li> <li>parents/guardians who do not adhere to the Code of Conduct will face disciplinary measures and possibly suspension from the team</li> </ul>
Communications Policy	<ul> <li>FAST's primary method of communication is email and we ask that you check it frequently</li> <li>Other methods of communication include: FAST Website, Social Media and News Releases (usually Daily Gleaner)</li> </ul>
Discipline Policy	<ul> <li>FAST has adopted and follows SNB's Discipline Policy – this is for all swimmers, their parents/guardians and FAST volunteers</li> <li>Minor and major infractions are explained</li> <li>Hearing and Appeals process outlined</li> </ul>
Family Participation Plan (FPP)	<ul> <li>Parents/guardians with swimmers in our competitive programs are required to volunteer a minimum # of hours/swim season</li> <li>If you do not meet the min hourly requirement, your FAST account is charged for \$15/hour not volunteered</li> <li>The purpose of this plan is to ensure we have enough volunteers to run our Club and swim meets/competitions</li> </ul>

	Special consider may be given at the discretion of the Board of Directors
	(ie. Single parent families, illness, etc)
	<ul> <li>Hours volunteered by swimmers are not counted against this</li> </ul>
	requirement
Group Transfer	Coaches may deem it necessary for a swimmer to transfer to another
Guidelines	group temporarily (switch practices) or permanently (group transfer)
	<ul> <li>Guidelines outline factors used to consider these transfers</li> </ul>
Injury Management &	<ul> <li>FAST takes injuries and recovery seriously</li> </ul>
Recovery Policy	<ul> <li>Depending on various factors outlined in this policy, coaches may ask</li> </ul>
	swimmers to take a break from training and/or consult a medical
	professional
	FAST has a partnership with Max Health Institute who will see our
	swimmers within a 48 hour period
National Performance	FAST maintains as part of its budget a National Performance Fund (NPF)
Fund	This fund is used to pay for the expenses related to a FAST coach
	attending a national swim meet
	<ul> <li>Swimmer expenses for these meets are the responsibility of their family and is not covered by this funding</li> </ul>
Practice Cancellation	Just because school is cancelled does not mean FAST practice is
Policy	cancelled
	Email notification will be sent out should any practice be cancelled
Fee & Refund Policy	Pre Competitive groups have 1 week to request a refund for the session

	30 days notice must be given for competitive groups
	<ul> <li>No refunds will be given after Jan 1 for competitive groups</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>A \$25 cancel fee applies to all competitive group cancellations</li> </ul>
	Convenience Fee, Insurance Fees and Pool Fund fees are non-refundable

Parent Liaison	Each competitive group will have a designated Parent Liaison
Guidelines	Liaisons will provide additional support and communication to their
	specific group

Registration Guidelines	All swimmers must be assessed by a FAST coach prior to registration
	Online Registration must be completed including waivers and code of
	conduct  At least 1 parent/guardian per family is required to held current Pespect
	<ul> <li>At least 1 parent/guardian per family is required to hold current Respect</li> <li>In Sport Parent Certification</li> </ul>
	Payment of fees and insurance required before a swimmer can attend

Registration Fee	Families may apply for FAST Fee Assistance (FFA)
Assistance Policy	May cover registration, meet entry and clothing/gear requirements
	Based on current Low Income Cut Offs (LICOs) in Canada or the families
	country of residency

	<ul> <li>FFA funding is net of any grants or other sponsorship monies received (ie. From jumpstart or other)</li> </ul>
Team Travel Code of Conduct	<ul> <li>Separate and in addition to the FAST Code of Conduct</li> <li>Outlines expectations and responsibilities of the swimmer, coaches and chaperones attending any Team Travel</li> <li>Must be reviewed by group travelling prior to or at the beginning of the trip</li> </ul>
Team Travel Policy	<ul> <li>Minimum practice attendance to go on Team Trip is 80%</li> <li>Non-refundable deposit (1<sup>st</sup> payment) and Letter of Intent must be received when committed to attend</li> <li>Chaperones will not share rooms with any swimmer unless coach is a parent, guardian, sibling or spouse)</li> <li>Rule of Two is always adhered to</li> <li>Swimmers cannot ride in a coach or chaperone's vehicle without another adult present, unless prior written parental permission is obtained</li> <li>For overnight trips, athletes are paired with other athletes of the same sex and similar age/maturity</li> <li>Medicine is the responsibility of the swimmer</li> </ul>
Waiting List Policy	<ul> <li>Pre Competitive Program – athletes are placed on the wait list in the order their request to be added is received (time stamps used)</li> <li>If requested, swimmers who for medical reasons need to stop swimming may be put on the waiting list</li> </ul>
