2. Warm-Up Information:
 - a. Warm-Up: 8:00 – 9:10 AM
 - b. Lane 9 for Para Swimmers Only
 - c. Lanes 0, 1, 2 for Masters Swimmers Only
 - d. Lanes 3 – 8 for Age Group Swimmers
 - e. Diving Lanes will be opened at 8:40 AM (Lanes 7, 8 & 3) One way swimming only
 - i. If you require an extended period for dives, please speak to meet management.
 - f. Warm-Up will conclude at 8:55 AM
 - g. Please remind swimmers to enter feet first.
3. Scratches are to be submitted by 8:150 AM
4. Competition is to start at 9:05 AM
5. There will be marshalling for this meet.
6. No starting ledges for the Backstroke
7. No starting blocks for the 25M events. Swimmers will start off of the bulkhead.
8. Hospitality will be offered in the classroom for coaches and for officials.
9. Please ensure your swimmers use the garbage cans and recycling receptacles on deck. Please ensure your team's area is clean prior to the conclusion of the meet.
10. Personal best stickers and heat winner stickers will be given to swimmers upon the conclusion of each heat.
11. Two (2) Age Group door prizes will be presented. One (1) Masters door prize will be presented. The winning relay team will be presented with prizes.
12. Swimmers can choose to participate in Swimmer Bingo. Each Club will receive Bingo cards for their swimmers and will be provided instructions as to how swimmers can win the Swimmer Bingo Door Prize.
13. Results will be posted on Meet Mobile. Meet mobile results are unofficial. All final results will be emailed out to the attending Clubs (as requested) and the Hy-tek file will be made available for download on the Swim Sask website.
14. World Aquatic Points rankings will be updated following the Saskatchewan Racing Series – November 2, 2025.
