

Hyack Club Records Program

Swimmers! This is an exciting opportunity to focus on breaking as many club records as you can! Hyack will be offering prize money for club records broken during the course of the year. The payouts will be handed out at the annual awards banquet. There are special incentive levels for breaking records, with the intention of having current swimmers attempting to break some of the records that have been on the Record Board since the 1970's. The prize outline is as follows:

Records from the 1970's: \$125

Records from the 1980's: \$100 or 4 points

Records from the 1990's: \$75 or 3 points

Records from 2000-2005: \$50 or 2 points

Records from 2006 – current: \$25 or 1 point

- 1. There is a limit of \$1000 per year for club records. In the instance of many club records broken and the allotted value for each record totalling more than \$1,000 limit; then the point system will be used to divide the money pool amongst the winning swimmers.
- 2. When the **Point** system has to be used, records from the 1970's have no point value and will be paid out first. Remaining records will be paid on the point system from the residual prize pool total.
- 3. Relays will be awarded at ¼ value to each member
- 4. In the case of a record being broken several times, the final swimmer (s) to break the record will be deemed the prize winners.
- 5. Record prize winners must be present members in good standing with the club.
