

How to sign up for an Official's eLearning Clinic


Step 1

Sign into <https://swimming.canada.sportsmanager.ie/>

Step 2

Next if you don't have a personal account, you will have to create an account. You can do this by clicking Register/Renew under the Memberships tab. (bottom left)

Register yourself as an official.




Step 3

Step 5


Select Group – “Official” and click Login to LMS (Red banner)
