MEET INFORMATION:

Please read the meet package for all other information regarding this competition.

FACILITY ACCESS:

Entry:

Please use the main entrance and go through the cafeteria to the spectator's area. Coaches, Swimmers, Officials, and Volunteers will access the pool deck via the staircase beside the Kinette Room. Please **do not use the main turnstiles for entrance.**

Parking:

Parking is free, but limited.

COACHES' MEETING:

There will be a brief coaches' meeting at 12:50 PM by the Meet Managers Office

WARMUP INFO:

Per City of Edmonton regulations, a 25m swim test is mandatory for all swimmers under 8 years of age. The swim test will occur at the start of warm-up (1:00 PM) in Lane '0'/gutter lane of the East Pool, starting block end.

Warm-up/down Lanes (West Pool):

Three (3) warm-up/down lanes will be available for the duration of the competition in the West Pool.

MARSHALLING:

- Marshalling is in place for this competition
- Swimmers should arrive at the marshalling area approximately 15 min prior to the anticipated start of their race
- Swimmers arriving at marshalling too early will be asked to return to their coaches and team area
- Marshals are not responsible for swimmers missing their race

If a swimmer misses a race and still wishes to swim, a coach should approach the referee with the swimmer and speak with them directly

START END:

- All 50m and longer races will start from the starting block end.
- 25m races will start from the North End.

SCRATCHES:

Swim Alberta Scratch rule will be in effect for this competition.

Late scratches are to be submitted by **1:00 PM** through the <u>online scratch form</u>. A QR code sign will also be available at the Administration Desk.

AWARDS:

'I Beat My Time' Ribbons:

Best time ribbons ('I Beat My Time') will be awarded to swimmers who beat their entry time for the respective race.

Bell Heats:

Prizes for bell heats will be awarded throughout the competition.

OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

- Results will be posted on Meet Mobile. Meet mobile results are unofficial and all final results will be published to Swimming Canada after the end of the meet.
- Heat sheets will be provided to coaches and officials, but there will NOT be any heat sheets available
 for sale. Finalized heat sheets will be posted on the Olympian Swim Club website OSC Hosted Meets
- Hospitality will be offered in the Aquatic Lecture Room for Officials, Volunteers, and coaches.
- Please remind all swimmers of the warm up rules, as they will be adhered to during each warm up session.
- Please remind your team to use the garbage bags and recycling receptacles provided. The facility
 requests that bleachers are cleared of all garbage by the end of the session. It would be greatly appreciated
 if you could assist us in this area.
