## Technical Bulletin # 1 – Dec 8, 2025

J.P. Fiset 2025 is close to reaching its swimmer capacity. We appreciate everyone's participation and patience, and we will do everything we can to meet the planned session report times.

#### **ACCREDITATION:**

Accreditation will be available for each team in designated envelopes. These envelopes will be available at the east end of the pool on Thursday, Dec. 11, when the Meet Manager's room opens at 1 p.m. Swimmers are required to use these tags to access the facility for every session. Prepopulated relay cards for Thursday ONLY will also be in these envelopes. Confirm or update the names, then have your teams hand the "card" to the timer for their relay lane.

#### **FACILITY ACCESS:**

Access to the change rooms and the pool deck will be through the cafeteria area to the right in the Kinsmen lobby. Please do not use the main turnstiles to enter the facility.

#### **COACHES' MEETING:**

The coaches meeting will be held on Friday, December 12 at 7:15 a.m. on deck. All clubs must have a coach representative present at the meeting. The location will be announced.

#### **GENERAL POOL & WARMUP INFO:**

- The facility has two 8 lane 25 metre race pools. Prelims in east and west pool, finals in east pool.
- The east pool is underneath the large scoreboard; west pool is next to the dive tank.
- If needed, one lane will be designated for Para Swimmers during warm-up.
- One backstroke start lane will be available, during each session in which there is a backstroke event (Friday, Saturday and Sunday). Backstroke ledges will be used and provided for warmups.
- The diving tank will be in use during the meet. Please ask your swimmers to give divers adequate space and be mindful of shared spaces.

#### **THURSDAY WARM-UP LANES FOR OUT-OF-TOWN CLUBS**

OSC has booked five lanes on December 11 between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. for use by out-of-town JP Fiset teams ONLY at the Kinsmen Sports Centre. Please feel free to use this lane space at your convenience, noting that it will also be used by/available to other out of town teams.

#### **WARM-UP LANES (training pool):**

During prelims, the training pool is available for warm up, cool down.

- Please remind all swimmers of the warmup rules, as they will be adhered to during each warm-up session.
- Hospitality will be offered in the Kinnette Room for officials and coaches. Please see the enclosed hospitality sheet for times and the menu. The Kinnette Room is on the second level, at the west end near the diving tank.
- Please remind your team to use the garbage bags and recycling bins provided. The facility requests that bleachers are cleared of all garbage by the end of the session. It would be greatly appreciated if you could help with this.
