Committee Responsibilities

The Swim Meet Committee will assist with various areas including:

- **Before the Meet:** Planning and coordination, vendor communication, equipment logistics, volunteer scheduling, and setting up courses for new officials.
- **During the Meet:** On-deck support, liaison between officials and management, and assisting referees or covering officiating positions as needed. Supporting general meet operations
- **After the Meet:** Equipment take-down, Vendor wrap-up and logistics, facility cleanup, and post-meet evaluation.
