SKSC Mission and Motto Review



These core values are the essence of the organization, the fundamental beliefs and what we hold closes to our hearts, and what the team is based upon




- 1.) Value the Process: The process to excellence (the journey) is one that all will take. "The process is more important than the destination" Dr. K. Bell
- 2.) Respect the Process: It is easy to respect the process when things are going well, but what about when it's not. The road to success is never easy, nor straight. Respect what you and others are trying to achieve, respect the coaches, the team and your fellow teammate for the process that has been presented and undertaken.
- **3.) Contribute to the Process:** Contribute to the process by fostering SKSC mission statement and club motto both in and out of the pool. Contribute not by just paying fees, but getting involved, leading by example, by making this journey together as a swimmer, teammate, parent, family. If we all contribute, the limits are endless, and better for everyone.
