



Swimming New Brunswick Post-Secondary Scholarship

Eligibility

Applicants must be registered with Swim New Brunswick to be eligible for this Scholarship.

Applicants who are attending post-secondary school outside of New Brunswick must be registered with Swim New Brunswick for a minimum of 120 days in the swimming calendar year (September 1 to August 31) and attend at least 1 provincial competition in the last swim season.

All applicants must be accepted to a post-secondary institution in the year of the scholarship award and registered with a recognized Swim Canada registered program.

Applicants are not limited to those attending their first year of post-secondary education.

Applicants who have previously received this award are not eligible for a second award.

Value

The total value of scholarships to be awarded annually by Swim New Brunswick is \$2,000 CAD.

Two (2) successful applicants will receive one installment of \$1,000 CAD.

If there are not two (2) applicants annually, the remainder of the award will be held in the scholarship fund investment and awarded at the Board of Directors' discretion within the same year.

Deadline

All applicants must submit the completed application form found on the Swimming New Brunswick website no later than **Jan 15, 2026**

Awards will be reviewed and released by **March 15, 2026**

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The Swimming New Brunswick Scholarship will be funded from the earnings of the Investment Portfolio annually. In the event that the Investment Portfolio held by BMO Nesbitt Burns does not earn sufficient funds to make the awards annually, funding will be allotted within the annual budget for the current year, only. The Board of Directors will revisit the viability of the scholarship fund during the development of the annual budget, and no later than August 15 of each calendar year.

The Swimming New Brunswick Scholarship will be awarded to the two (2) individual applicants who score the highest number of points on their application as determined by the Review Committee.

The Review Committee must be made up of a minimum of 5 persons.

- At least 1 person on the Review Committee will have previous coaching experience.
- At least 1 person but not more than 3 persons on the Review Committee will be a member of the Board of Directors for Swim New Brunswick.
- No member of the Review Committee can be a relative or coach/former coach of an eligible candidate.
- No member of the Review Committee can be a Board Member for a Team registered with Swimming New Brunswick of an eligible candidate.

Applicant scoring will be provided as follows:
