



TRURO CENTURIONS SWIM CLUB VOLUNTEER POLICY

TCSC relies on family volunteers to support swim meets, fundraising and club operations. Volunteer commitments are assessed per family based on the swimmer registered in the highest practice group.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Practice Group	Points Required	Volunteer Commitment
Centurion Skills	0	\$0
Nova Tech	4	\$200
Junior Development	6	\$300
Junior Provincial	8	\$400
Atlantic Development	10	\$500
Atlantic	12	\$600

Each volunteer point is valued at \$50. Families may complete volunteer activities or pay the equivalent commitment.

EARNING VOLUNTEER POINTS

Volunteer Opportunity	Points Earned
Swim meet timer	1 point per session
Other swim meet official	2 points per session
Canteen or hospitality volunteer	1 point per session
Fundraising project lead	4 points per project
Equipment or uniform coordinator	4 points
Chair of Officials or Executive member	4 points
Board member	2 points

Additional opportunities and point values may be established by the Board throughout the season. Families are encouraged to volunteer at a TCSC-hosted swim meet.

TRACKING POINTS

Families are responsible for tracking their volunteer points throughout the season. The Vice-President will review points at year-end, and invoices for outstanding commitments will be issued in July.

MID-SEASON REGISTRATION

Volunteer requirements for swimmers joining after the season begins will be prorated.

OUTSTANDING COMMITMENTS

Families completing the required points will not be charged. All outstanding volunteer commitments must be settled before the swimmer account is closed.

PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Families unable to complete the requirement or pay the outstanding amount should contact the Treasurer to discuss a payment arrangement.
