The group trains five times per week.

The successful candidate will enjoy working with young athletes, creating a positive learning environment, and helping swimmers develop confidence and skills both in and out of the water. This position is ideal for a coach looking to gain experience in athlete development within a supportive coaching environment.

The 12 Stream is led by Jan Bidrman, whose international coaching experience and mentorship provide valuable support for developing coaches.

## Key Responsibilities

- Plan and deliver age-appropriate training sessions focused on technical development and skill acquisition.
- Support long-term athlete development through consistent coaching, encouragement, and accountability.
- Work collaboratively with the Stream Lead and Age Group Head Coach in implementing seasonal training plans.
- Monitor athlete progress and communicate with athletes and parents as required.
- Attend designated competitions, meetings, and club events.
- Contribute positively to the culture and development pathway of the club.
