## **National Youth Development Coach**

The University of Calgary Swim Club is seeking a motivated coach to work within our National Stream, leading a group of approximately 15 - 25 athletes aged 12 -15.

This group represents the entry point into our National Stream and consists primarily of emerging provincial-level swimmers, with a small number of athletes progressing toward junior national standards. Athletes are highly engaged in the sport, train six times per week, and compete regularly throughout the season.

This position is ideal for a coach pursuing NCCP Level 2 certification or considering coaching as a long-term career. The role provides the opportunity to work within a high-performance environment while receiving mentorship from experienced coaches and contributing to the development of athletes progressing toward provincial and national levels.

Due to the training and competition schedule, this position is best suited to someone with a flexible secondary job or schedule.

## **Key Responsibilities**

- Design and deliver training sessions that support athlete progression toward provincial and junior national standards.
- Implement seasonal training plans in collaboration with the Head Coach and Assistant Head Coach.
- Provide technical instruction, race analysis, and individualized feedback.
- Attend competitions and training camps as required.
- Foster a positive, accountable, and high-performance training environment.
- Collaborate with coaching staff to support athlete progression throughout the club pathway.





## Qualifications

- Energetic, enthusiastic, self-directed, and organized.
- Passionate about developing athletes to meet their full potential.
- NCCP Level 1 Coach certification (or higher) strongly encouraged.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Successful candidates will be subject to a police vulnerable sector check.

Opportunities may exist for the successful candidate to assist with and collaborate across other training groups within the club, from age group development programs through to National Stream athletes, based on interest, availability, and club needs.
