Why do we need to volunteer and how do we sign up:

Swim meets will not run without volunteers! It is the responsibility of the host club of the meet to provide volunteers to run the event. If your child is attending one of the above hosted meets you must volunteer for the meet to fulfill your point obligations. There is one meet listed above that CH/SD swimmers will not swim at, but parents are asked to officiate at.
