

Registration for meets and Volunteering for meets

You must register by the Sign-up deadline on our website for each meet or you will not be entered into the meet. You sign up on the website by going to the "Events" Dino below the picture on the home page of our website, then find the meet name; Example: "Halloween Howler"; click on the event and select "Accept".

Why do we need to volunteer and how do we sign up:

Swim meets will not run without volunteers! It is the responsibility of the host club of the meet to provide volunteers to run the event. If your child is attending one of the above hosted meets you must volunteer for the meet to fulfill your point obligations.

You can find more information on Volunteer requirements on the "Members" tab of the website- then under "Policies" and Officiating Info". A list of the swim meets can be found in the members section under "registration docs" and "officiating commitment." **You will be able to sign up for Officiating/volunteering positions on our website under the events tabs right after swimmer registration closes for the event.** A tutorial on how to sign up for officiating is in the "UCSC Parent Handbook" and there is a video in "Info Videos" (found in the members section under "Info you Should Know"). Access to the members section is available when you are signed in. If you are new to UCSC your account will be created on the website within one week of us receiving your registration forms.

You are responsible for volunteering at listed high level meets each season hosted by UCSC. Your swimmer will not swim at this meet however you are required to volunteer.
