




# FINANCIAL OVERVIEW INCOME (Y/E 2023)



Paul Dardis, Jordan Greber, Alexanne Lepage, Aiden Norman and Lorne Wigginton represented Canada at the 2023 World Aquatics Junior Swimming Championships in Netanya, Israel from September 4-9, 2023. Alexanne took home a gold medal in the 100M breaststroke and a silver medal as part of the women's 4x100M medley relay. Lorne Wigginton captured a bronze Medal in the 400 IM.

### INTERNATIONAL EVENTS-JUNIOR

Four (4) UCSC swimmers were selected to represent Canada at the 2024 Junior Pan Pacific Championships in Canberra, Australia. Congratulations to Nick Duncan, Jordan Greber, Laon Kim, and Aiden Norman.



Canada's silver medal performance in the Men's 4x100M Medley Relay included three (3) UCSC swimmers, Nick Duncan, Laon Kim and Aiden Norman.

Aiden and Laon also contributed to the relays with bronze medals in the 4x100M and 4x200M relays and a silver medal in the 4x100M Mixed Medley Relay for Aiden. Aiden added individual gold medals in the 100M and 200M Back while Laon added a silver medal performance in the 100M Free. Congratulations UCSC swimmers!




UCSC uses **Athlee** swim cameras to analyze strokes and provide feedback to swimmers.
