UNIVERSITY OF CALGARY SWIM CLUB (UCSC) VISITATION GUIDELINES

As one of the premier Swim Clubs in Canada we receive requests for non UCSC swimmers to train with UCSC. UCSC will follow these guidelines outlined below for non UCSC swimmers visiting the club for short term training opportunities.



Transient Visitations - A non UCSC member is in the city and requires an opportunity to train. This request will be forwarded to the Director of Swimming or the Assistant Head Coach for approval.

Program Visitations - A non UCSC member that is seeking an opportunity to visit UCSC will be placed in a group based on skill. There will be a predetermined number of workouts for this visitation. This request will be forwarded to the Director of Swimming or the Assistant Head Coach for approval.

Long Term Visitations - A non UCSC member has asked for a consistent visitation to supplement their current training position. This will be vetted to the Director of Programs and in consultation with the coaches on a case by case bases, to establish fairness to the membership with regards to training space and compensation to UCSC.

Visiting UCSC Swimmer - A previous member of UCSC who has moved out of town and wishes to return to compete at a swim meet as a UCSC member. This situation must be discussed with the Director of Swimming or Assistant Head Coach as well as the Director of Programs and the Coaches of the Squad affected. If approved, the swimmer must be registered as UCSC through the office and resulting fees would need to be paid. The swimmer must purchase a UCSC t-shirt and club cap if he/she does not already have one.
