# **Artistic Swim School**

These classes are designed to gradually teach the basics of artistic swimming in an environment that is enjoyable, creative and supportive. This program teaches basic artistic swimming skills and working as a team.

- ⇒ Participation in Watershows and Club Development meet
- $\Rightarrow$  Receive report cards and certificate at the end of the season
- $\Rightarrow$  Evaluation from our head coach at the end of the season

# **REQUIREMENTS:**

- $\Rightarrow$  comfortable in deep water.
- $\Rightarrow$  able to swim 25 meters unassisted
- $\Rightarrow$  able to tread water for 30 seconds

## **CLASSES:**

#### LEVEL ONE: ages 7-9

 $\Rightarrow$  new to artistic swimming or recommended by coach for level 1

Tues & Thur 4-5:30 pm

#### LEVEL TWO: ages 9-12\* or younger if invited by head coach

- $\Rightarrow$  returning from previous class <u>and</u> recommended by coach for level 2
- ⇒ previous artistic swimming experience and strong swimmer

Tues & Thur 5:30-7 pm

# PAYMENTS

## Payments to CLUB: CLASS FEE + Annual Club registration fee

#### 1. Annual Club Registration Fee:

 $\Rightarrow$  \$40 paid to club once for 2025/26 season due Oct 30, 2025

#### 1. Class Fees

- $\Rightarrow$  There are 7 monthly payments made on the 30th of each month
- $\Rightarrow$  First payment due Oct 30, 2025

Tue/Thu class \$139 each month for 7 months

Payment is by pre-authorized debit.

When you have registered through the CLUB WEBSITE, a pre-authorized debit form will be emailed to you with your confirmation of registration.

# **Payment to BC/Canada Artistic Swimming:**

Annual BC/Canada Artistic Swimming registration/insurance fee

Participation in any artistic swimming activity requires this for insurance coverage

You pay this directly when you register your swimmer online through the RAMP registration system (separate from club class registration)

Payment online with credit card (club not involved with this portion)

- 2025/26 BC Artistic Swimming fee: \$30
- Approximate Canada Artistic Swimming fee: \$10 (this is from last year)

## **VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS 2025/2026**

# Families of athletes in <u>Swim School, Olympic Dreams, Provincial</u> <u>Stream & National Stream</u> are expected to volunteer each season.

#### Why?

- Our club and sport is run by volunteers and could not operate without them.
- The meets we host and meets we attend out of town could not run without volunteers.
- Volunteering is a great way to learn more about our sport.
- Volunteering is crucial to your athlete, your club, and the sport of artistic swimming.

#### What is it?

- Each season, every athlete's family is required to volunteer to earn a minimum number of points or pay a Volunteer Fee (charged to your club account at the end of the season in June)
- families (including athletes, extended family & friends) can earn volunteer points during the season
- <u>each point is worth \$25</u>
- if all points are earned during the season congratulations and thank you! You will not be charged the Volunteer Fee
- If a family has fulfilled part of their points, the charge will be prorated at a rate of \$25 per volunteer point not earned or reported. (charged to your club account at the end of the season in June)

#### **Reporting Volunteer Hours**

It is *your* responsibility to email your volunteer time to our volunteer coordinator.

#### Victoria Artistic Swimming Development Program Cancellation Policy:

A swimmer that wishes to withdraw from the club is required to give 30 days written notice to the registrar (jennifervicsynchro@gmail.com) and bookkeeper (victoriaasbookkeeper@gmail.com) of the club. Class fees are payable until the expiry of the 30 day notice period. The initial Season Club Registration Fee and BC/Canada Artistic Swimming Season Registration/Insurance Fee are non-refundable.

## **CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT:**

# **CLUB PAYMENT via Pre-authorized debit:**
