



VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS 2026/2027

Families of athletes in Limited Competitive, Provincial Stream & National Stream are expected to volunteer each season.

Why?

- Our club and sport is run by volunteers and could not operate without them.
- The meets we host and meets we attend out of town could not run without volunteers.
- Volunteering is a great way to learn more about our sport.
- *Volunteering is crucial to your athlete, your club, and the sport of artistic swimming.*

What is it?

- Each season, every athlete's family is required to volunteer to earn a minimum number of points** or pay a Volunteer Fee (charged to your club account at the end of the season in June)
- families (including athletes, extended family & friends) can earn volunteer points during the season
- each point is worth \$25
- if all points are earned during the season congratulations and thank you! You will not be charged the Volunteer Fee
- If a family has fulfilled part of their points, the charge will be prorated at a rate of \$25 per volunteer point not earned or reported. (charged to your club account at the end of the season in June)

**** per family, not per athlete**

PARENT VOLUNTEER REGISTRATION ON RAMP

- **Register yourself on RAMP before** you to volunteer at any artistic swimming activity, example Swimathon
- *This is not required to attend club meetings.*
- Register yourself as a volunteer (FREE) when you register your athlete in RAMP!
