

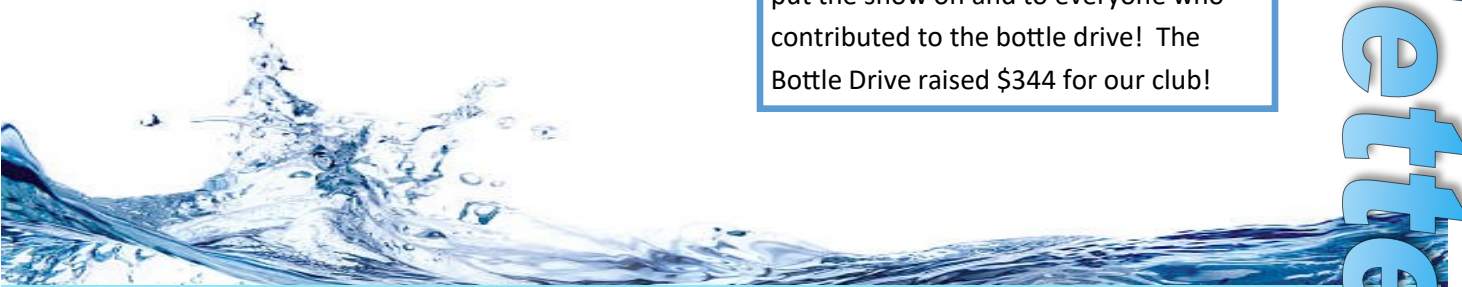


Fantastic Water Show!
